Rialacha – Féile Rules

- A. Any Objections must be lodged in writing to the Féile committee with a fee of €20.00 and will be only accepted from registered teachers
- B. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition.
- C. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiún.
- D. Age is reckoned from January 1st.
- E. The adjudicator's decision is final
- F. The use of artificial carriage aids is strictly forbidden. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required - Doctors Certificate) will be exempt from this rule
- G. The Féile Committee will not accept responsibility for personal injury or personal articles lost/damaged
- H. The Féile Committee will as far as practicable provide surfaces suitable for Irish Dancing. However, the Féile Committee cannot accept liability whatsoever, for any injuries sustained while on Stage. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by the dancer, parent or guardian
- I. Make-up is not permitted in the first two grades up to and including Under 12 age group
- J. Dancers in Bun Grád or Tus Grád must wear:- Girls class costumes, day dress or Skirt & Blouse / Boys Class Costume or Pants & Shirt
- K. At all times, dancers must be properly attired. Dancers should not change costume in the main dancing hall
- L. No block, en Pointe work, stationery or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including Under 12 age group, with the exception of the 11-12 age group who may perform this as & from 1st Sept.
- M. Should a dancer fall on stage, the adjudicator MUST ring the bell to stop the performance of the dancer (s). The dancer (s) so affected will be permitted to re dance at the discretion of the adjudication panel, or by a majority of adjudicators, where there is a judging panel. Should, in the opinion of the stage steward, having obtained medical advice if necessary, a dancer be unfit to re dance and if such dancer insists on his/her right to do so then the dancer concerned may be permitted to re-dance on completion of a declaration form exonerating the committee of liability for any consequences.
- N. Should a dancer lose a heel or a complete shoe he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer, where applicable, to continue dancing uninhibited. In such a case, the dancer concerned will be permitted to re-dance as soon as it is deemed practicable by the stage steward.

Summer Féis Rule (Munster Specific) Feiseanna taking place in the Munster region from the completion of the Mini-Munsters to September 1st. For Dancers from the Munster Region the competition grading rule will not apply. Dancers who win 1st place in any competition will not be deemed to have won that dance in that grade. This applies to all dances and grades.

Grade Rules

A competition in which there are five competitors or less shall not count for grading purposes i.e. the winner of such a competition shall be entitled to dance again in a competition for the same dance in the same age group and grade. This rule includes the ÁRD Grade Solo competitions.

As of Jan 1st. 2009, for those competitions where grading occurs, the number of dancers that progress to the next grade is based on the number of competitors in the competition:-

- **Less or equal to 20** **1 dancer graded,**
- **Between 21 - 39** **2 dancers**
- **Greater or equal to 40** **3 dancers**

Bun Grád: Confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified, for that competition. in any other registered competition, under any age limit. Dancers must perform basic material only.

Tus Grád: Confined to competitors who have never previously won first place, for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition or under any age limit, other than in Bun Grád. Dancers must perform their first advanced material. This should exclude clicks, twists, swivels, cross keys, rocks etc.

Primary Grád: **(Munster specific criteria)** Confined to competitors who have never previously graded out of a competition for the dance specified, in any other registered competition, in any other grade or under any age limit other than in Bun or Tus or Primary Grade. Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Árd Grád competition. Solo costumes can be worn by dancers in this grade. Once a dancer wins a dance in Primary grade, they are no longer eligible to enter that dance in that grade again.

Mean Grád: Mean-grad competition shall be confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition, under the upper age-limit specified for the competition (or under a higher age-limit) outside of Bun-grad and Tus-grad. Dancers must perform their first advanced material. The same level of material can be performed for Mean-Grad and Árd-Grad

Preliminary (Pre-Lim) Grád: **(Munster specific criteria)** Confined to competitors who have never previously won an Árd competition for the dance specified for that competition in any other registered competition under any age limit. Winners of a Pre-Lim competition are not graded out. Only the winning of an Open competition or Championship will affect a dancer's participation in this grade. Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Árd Grád competition. Solo costumes can be worn by dancers in this grade.

Árd Grád: An Árd-grad competition shall be open to any dancer who satisfies all the following qualifying conditions :-

- Is a pupil of a registered teacher
- Is qualified to compete as regards age and place of residence
- Is not suspended from competitions under any Rule or by a decision of An Coimisiún or of a Regional Authority
- Is entered with the permission of his teacher

Where a dancer has won first prize and thereafter fails to win a prize for that particular dance, the teacher of that dancer may, when a period of two years has elapsed, apply to the regional council to have the dancer re-graded as a mean grad dancer.
