1. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY

The examination is open to people who have been registered for a period of 10 years as an ADCRG and are currently registered as an ADCRG.

2. COMPETENCY AND SUITABILITY

An applicant must be competent in administration and computer skills. Competency in Gaelige – Irish language if required.

3. DATES OF EXAMINATION

Examination dates and venues will be publicised by the Examination Authority via CLRG website.

4. APPLICATIONS AND FEES

Applications with Full Fees must be sent to the Coimisiún Office. Applications will be returned if full fee is not included. The application form must be fully completed and signed by the applicant after he or she has carefully read this syllabus and enclosures in full. Full fees must be paid by credit card/bank transfer. (Payment form available from CLRG office)

5. WITHDRAWALS AND FORFEITURE OF FEES

Candidates who withdraw application or who fail to attend will forfeit the full fee.

6. REPEAT EXAMINATION

This is a stand-alone examination. No repeats of individual sections of the exam allowed. However, a full repeat will be permitted.

7. RESULTS

The exam results will be emailed. Shortly thereafter, all candidates will receive the official result sheet showing the marks achieved in each section. Unsuccessful candidates will also receive details on each failed section. This will be the only communication a candidate will receive, directly or indirectly, in relation to the results of the examination. An Coimisiún, the Examination Authority or individual examiners will not enter into any further correspondence or discussion with a candidate or with anyone else acting on the candidate's behalf regarding an examination result

The decision of the examiners concerning any candidate's result, when confirmed by the Examination Authority, is final.

Clár Scrúdaithe - Syllabus of Examination

The examination consists of an information section and a practical section and candidates must attend both sections of the examination.

The information section includes a tutorial on grade exams 1 -10. You may be required to answer questions following the tutorial.

The practical section includes an assessment and grading exercise of dancers in grades 1 – 4 & grade 8.

Please note the following:

Grading: The Grade awarded to the candidate must be reflective of the performance in each dance performed.

Qualifying mark: 80%

Comments: must be positive and negative and must relate to the dancer's performance. Suitable constructive comments should be included for the further development of the dancer. Inappropriate comments must not be written on a comment sheet.

Qualifying mark: 80%

Paperwork: Comment sheets must be neat, legible, and tidy. There should be no spelling or grammatical errors. Dance names and grades being taken must be entered on the comment sheets. The results of both dances must be entered as a grade. This result must equate to the correct band. E.g., B+ B = B. Reminder that comments should not refer to dance or dancers' material but to their performance.

Qualifying mark: 80%

Computer Skills Test: A Grades Summary Sheet must be completed online and emailed for correction. Future grade exams may be fully computerized and include grades for chilis.

Qualifying mark: 80%

Failure to achieve the qualifying pass mark of 80% in any of the above sections will result in an unsuccessful result overall.

Instructions on Day of Exam

1. a) Candidates are not permitted to use or have on their desk or tables any papers, books or notebooks other than paper handed out by the examiners in charge. Neither may a candidate use electronic aids in lieu of written notes etc. The making of carbon copies of answer papers is not allowed.

b) During these sections any conversation or other contact between candidates is strictly forbidden.

c) Any rough work, diagrams, cancelled answers etc. made during these sections cannot be retained by the candidates but instead must be either handed up to an examiner (but will not of course be taken into account in the marking of candidates papers) or alternatively torn up in the presence of an examiner and placed in a receptacle provided for that purpose.

d). Candidates are not permitted to leave the examination room and return unless with the permission of, and accompanied by, a supervising official.
2. The examination supervisor may at their sole discretion immediately disqualify from an examination any candidate adjudged guilty by them of any breach of the foregoing regulations in sub-paragraph (1) above.
3. Candidates take the examination at their own risk.
