We are delighted to be in a new venue this year in the Carlton Hotel, Tyrrellstown, Dublin 15, which is situated within easy access of the M50 and Dublin Airport. If you require any assistance or help regarding travel, please do not hesitate to contact us. Some key points about our feis are as follows:

- Championship Stage in main hall
- Open Championships & Preliminary Championship will be adjudicated by 3 judges
- Preliminary Championships are incorporated in the Open Championship for ages U10 to U15.
- Perpetual Cup for winners of each Open Championship
- Sashes/Pennants will be awarded to the top 5 dancers in each Preliminary & Open Championship
- If there are 5 or more boys in a championship a separate result will be given
- If 20 dancers or more in an Open Championship, there will be a recall
- There will be a separate non recall set dance competition in Hall B for non-recalled dancers in each age group.
- Results will be given in Hall B and we have option to use another results area to ensure smooth running of feis

- Payment for entries will be taken on the day of the feis from 7.45am. We ask that all entries are emailed in advance to ensure a smooth running of the feis
- Tabulated results will be included in Championship & Preliminary Entry Fee
- Commentary of the event, results and awards will be on the Nina Burke School of Irish Dancing Facebook Page
- Raffle will be held on the day in aid of Children's Autism Charity – The Rainbow Club

- **Championships Age groups scheduled for same time slot will alternate each round.**

RIALACHA NA FEIS:

- 1. Age as from 1st January 2018.**
- 2. Entries only accepted from Teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rincí Gaelacha**
- 3. Adjudicator's decision is final. Objections must be lodged in writing within 1 hour of the announcement of the results, accompanied with a fee of €20.00.**
- 4. With regard to toe movements, no block enpointe, stationary or moving is not allowed to be performed for all ages up to under 13.**
- 5. A dancer may enter a preliminary competition if:**
 - a. They have not placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open Championship which has been judged by three or more adjudicators in the current calendar year**
 - b. They have not qualified for the World Championships 2018 or are a current world medal holder**
 - c. They have not won a Preliminary Championship in the calendar year**
- 6. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement is strictly prohibited**
- 7. An Coimisiun Rules will apply if disputes arise that are not covered by the above rules.**
