RIALACHA / RULES

- 1) Adjudicator's decision is final
- 2) Age as at 1st January 2018
- 3) Bun Grad & Tus Grad competitions are open to dancers from any region
- 4) In Bun Grad & Tus Grad, make-up will not be permitted in competitions up to and including the Under 12 age group. Dancers in all ages must wear either dress costumes or 'day clothes'
- 5) Mean Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age or grade or who have been upgraded. Basic Steps only are permitted.
- 6) Tus Grad confined to dancers who have never won 1st prize for that particular dance in any age in Tus Grad, Mean Grad or Ard Grad. Dancers may perform either basic steps or their first hard/difficult version of each dance. Steps in Tus Grad Heavy Jigs and Hornpipes must be similar to those used in St. Patrick's Day and Blackbird.
- 7) Dancers may only perform a dance in Mean Grad if they have never won 1st prize for that dance in Mean or Ard Grad in that age or a higher age.
- 8) Dances permitted in Rince Fionn are: Reel, Light Jig, Single Jig or Slip Jig.
- 9) Dances permitted in Rince Fionn are: Heavy Jig or Hornpipe.
- 10) Dancers must perform to the following speeds:
 - Bun Grad: Reel 125-128, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Heavy Jig 96, Hornpipe 144
 - Tus Grad: Reel 116-118, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 120, Heavy Jig 82, Hornpipe 130
 - Mean/Ard Grad: Reel 113, Light Jig 116, Single Jig 124, Slip Jig 113, Heavy Jig 73, Hornpipe 113
 - Traditional Set Dances: St. Patrick's Day 94, The Blackbird 144, Job of Asenay 96, Garden of Danes 138, King of the Fairies 130, Three Sea Captains 96, Jockey to the Fair 90
- 11) All competitors will be required to dance a MINIMUM number of 40 bars, except in Slip Jigs. Hornpipes & Bun Grad Reels where a MINIMUM number of 32 bars will be required.
- 12) No block, on point work, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for ages up to and including U11
- 13) The feis committee reserves the right to (a) transfer competitors results to a different hall and (b) alternate competitors, if it becomes necessary, in order to help the feis run more smoothly.
- 14) Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition.
- 15) Re-grading of dancers (in Bun Grad & Tus Grad)
 - Less than 30 dancers in competition – 1 dancer moves up to next grade
 - 31-50 dancers in competition – 2 dancers move up to next grade
 - Over 50 dancers in competition – 3 dancers move up to next grade
- 16) Make-Up (including false eyelashes and hair tint) will not be permitted for all age groups up to and including Under 16.

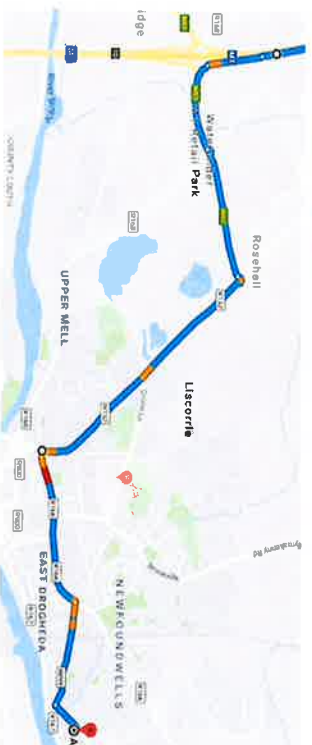

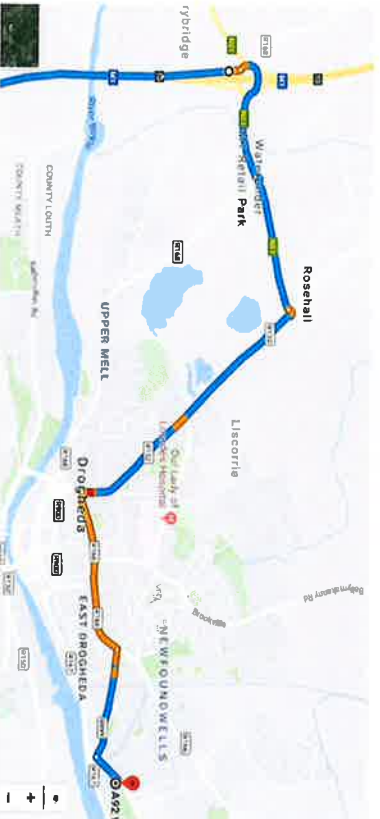
Directions to Greenhills Sports Complex - Eircode A92 WKX2

1. Take exit 10 - Drogheda North/Slane off M1
2. At exit ramp, take 1st exit to Drogheda - N51
3. At next roundabout take 2nd exit, again headed for Drogheda/Termonfeckin
4. At next roundabout take 2nd exit for Drogheda - R132
5. Continue on this road and at second set of lights, turn left onto Patrick St. / R166
6. Continue to the bottom of this road and turn left at the Y junction (L2307)
7. Greenhills will be on your right hand side on this road.

1. Take exit 10 - Drogheda North/Slane off M1

3. At next roundabout take 2nd exit, again headed for Drogheda/Termonfeckin
4. At next roundabout take 2nd exit for Drogheda - R132
5. Continue on this road and at second set of lights, turn left onto Patrick St. / R166
6. Continue to the bottom of this road and turn left at the Y junction (L2307)
7. Greenhills will be on your right hand side on this road.
