Rules & Regulations

1. Only basic steps must be danced in preliminary grade and grades I, 2 & 3.
2. The number of bars to be danced for Reel, Light Jig, Slip Jig, Single Jig, Heavy Jig and Hornpipe is 40 bars.
3. St.Patrick's Day, The Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, Three sea captains, Jockey to the Fair and King of the Fairies must be performed in a traditional style and manner.
4. The same set dance must not be performed in more than one grade from grades 9 to 12 inclusive.
5. A dancer must take all the grades in order from Grade I.
6. However a candidate may only attempt 3 consecutive grades at any one sitting.
7. Candidates must be able to adequately demonstrate practical and theoretical knowledge of all ceili dances as per "Ar Rinci Foirne as specified in the syllabus for Grades 5 to 12 inclusive.
8. Dance costumes should not be worn.
9. All dancers must provide previous reports before proceeding to higher grades. Please bring them with you to the exam.
10. Grade 11 may only be attempted by candidates of at least 16 years of age.
11. Grade 12 may only be attempted by candidates of at least 17 years of age.
12. A special application form and certificate/diploma will apply for grades 11 and 12.
13. All 12 Grade Examinations must be completed to be eligible to apply to apply for the T.C.R.G. Examination effective from 1st January 2018.
14. **Closing date for entries is Friday 3rd May 2019 to ensure an accurate timetable can be provided.**
