Rialacha

- 1. Age to be taken as on 1st January, 2019.
- 2. Entries accepted only from teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 3. The Adjudicator's decision is final. Adjudicators are to be approached by Committee members only.
- 4. Any objections must be made in writing to feis organisers within one hour, signed and accompanied by a fee of €20 which will be returned if objection is sustained.
- 5. The feis committee will not be responsible for any personal injury or articles lost at the feis. The committee, as far as practical, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be acceptance of these rules by a dancer and his/her parents/guardian.
- 6. Bungrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won a 1st place in that specific dance and basic steps only are permitted.
- 7. Tusgrad competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st place in Tusgrad or Meangrad for that specific dance. Basic steps or the first difficult version of each dance only.
- 8. <u>Preliminary</u> (8-9 years upwards) is confined to competitors who have not been placed in the top five in an Open Championship judged by three or more Adjudicators. The dancer must not have qualified for the World Championships in 2018 or 2019, (with the exception of boys who are eligible if they qualified but did not place in the top 3 at their Oireachtas and otherwise fulfil the requirements of Prelim). The dancer must not have won a Preliminary Championship more than two times in the current year. A dancer must not have recalled in the actual championship at the All Irelands in 2018 or 2019. If the dancer has not succeeded in placing in the top 5 but has won two Preliminary Championships in the current year, <u>they are eligible to dance preliminary again the following year</u>.
- 9. Make up, wigs or solo costumes are not permitted in the Bungrad or Tusqrad competitions.
- 10. Any form of unauthorised photography which has the ability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion is strictly forbidden.
